

How do I translate EDEKA  
next in Google Chrome?



## With the help of this instruction, you can ...

- Activate the translation function in your browser (Google Chrome)
- Display the EDEKA next translated
- Translate your EDEKA next courses

## Step 1: Adjust translation settings

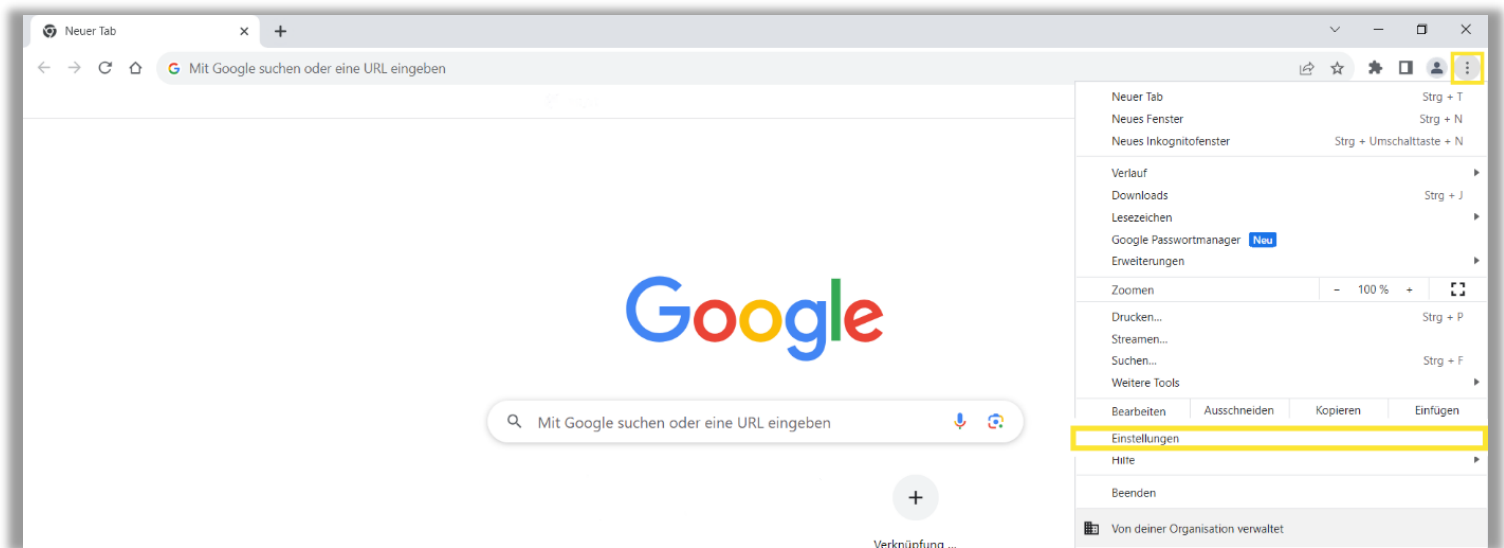
First open your Browser (Google Chrome).



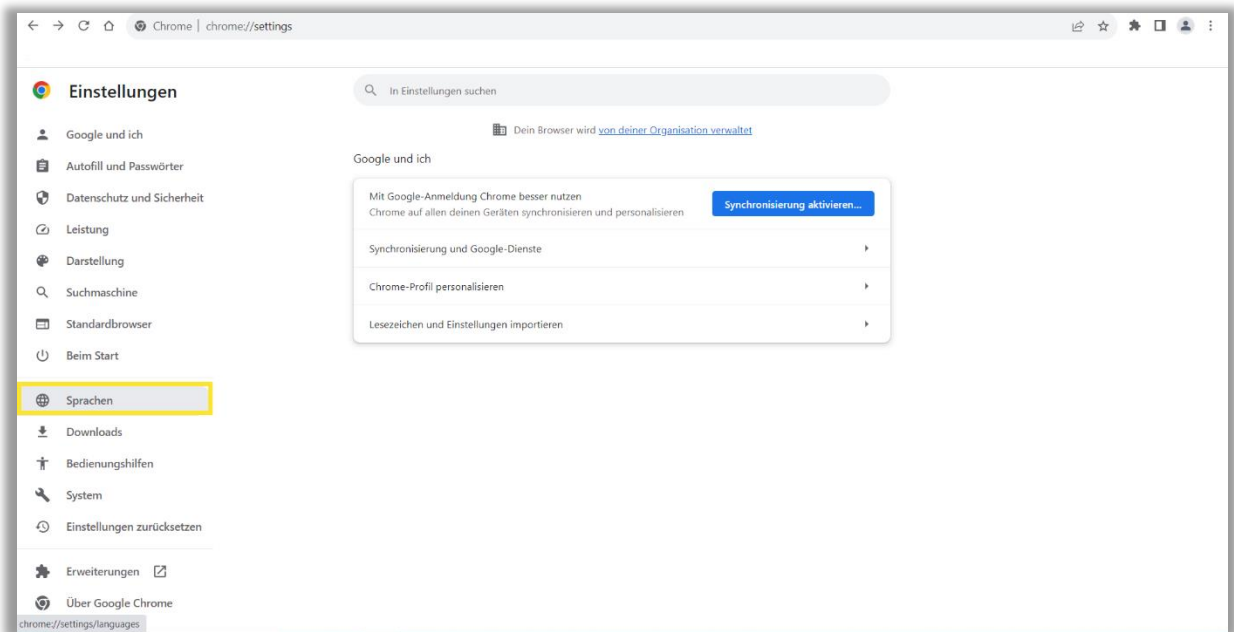

Click on the **three dots** on the **top right** and after that on **settings**.



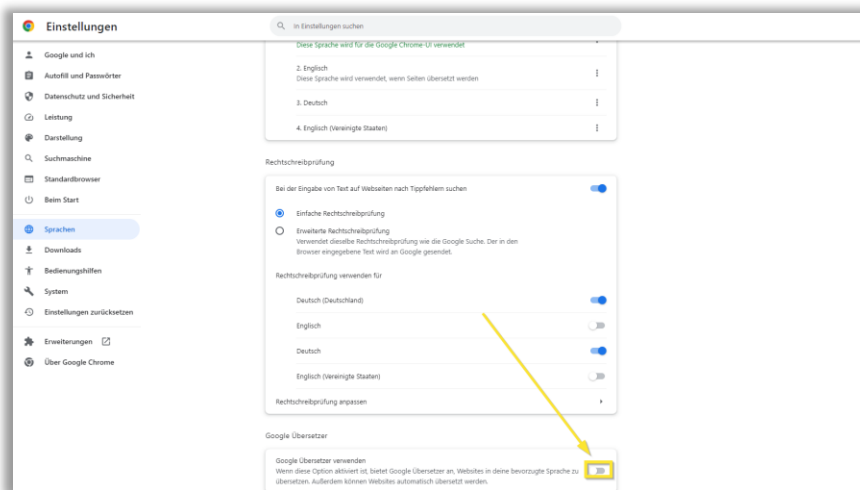
Click on the menu item **languages**.



## Activate the translation function

Navigate to the headline **Google Translate**

1 Activate the Google Translator.



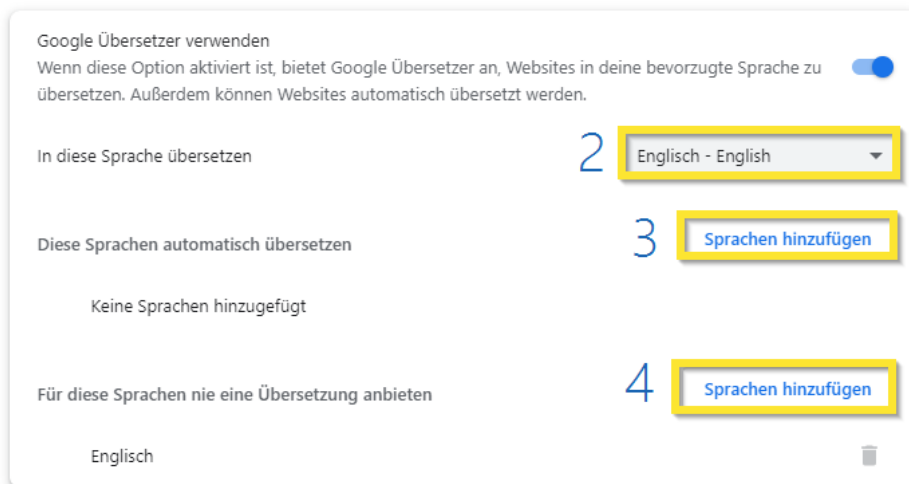
2 Select the desired language (e.g., English).

3 If you want the EDEKA next to always be automatically translated into your desired language, select German.



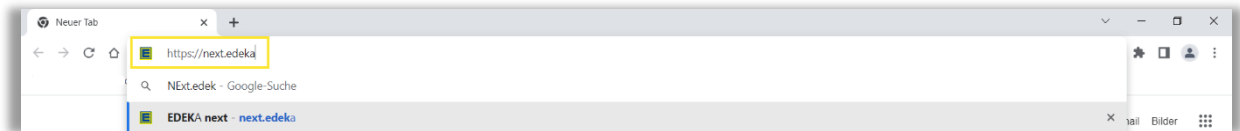
4 Select the desired language (e.g., English) This field must not be left blank.

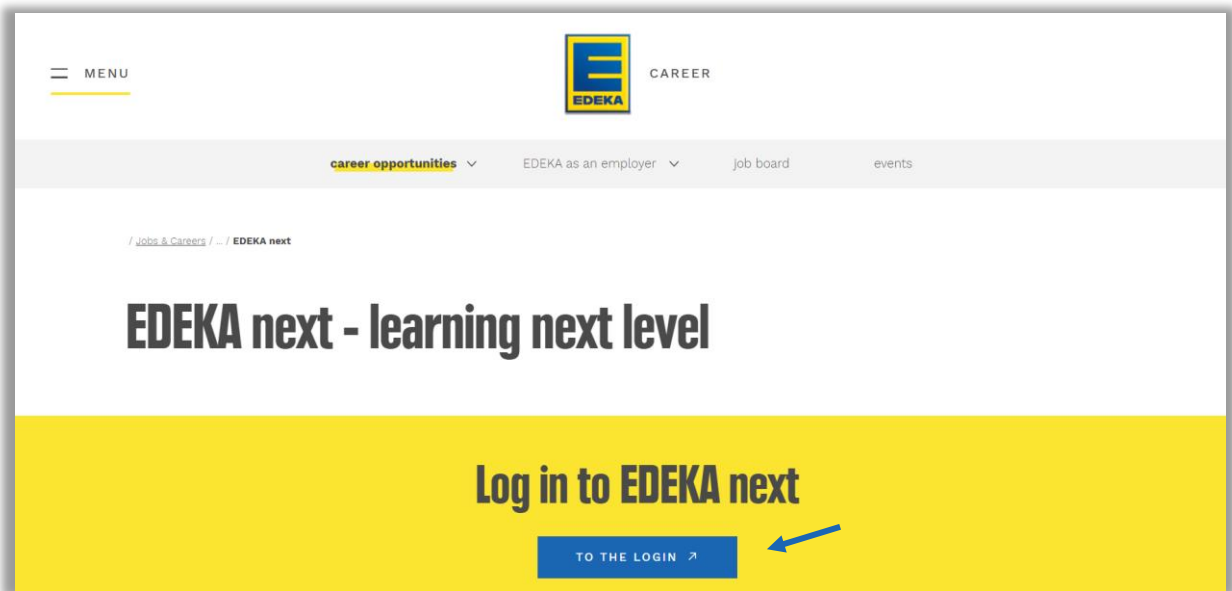


## Step 2: Log in to EDEKA next

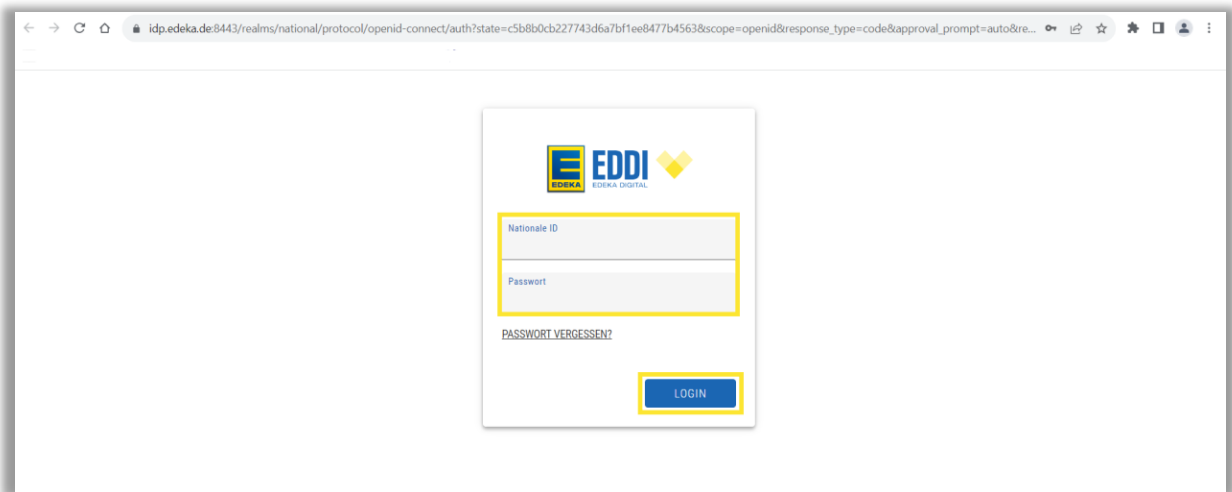
Enter [next.edeka](https://next.edeka) in the search bar.



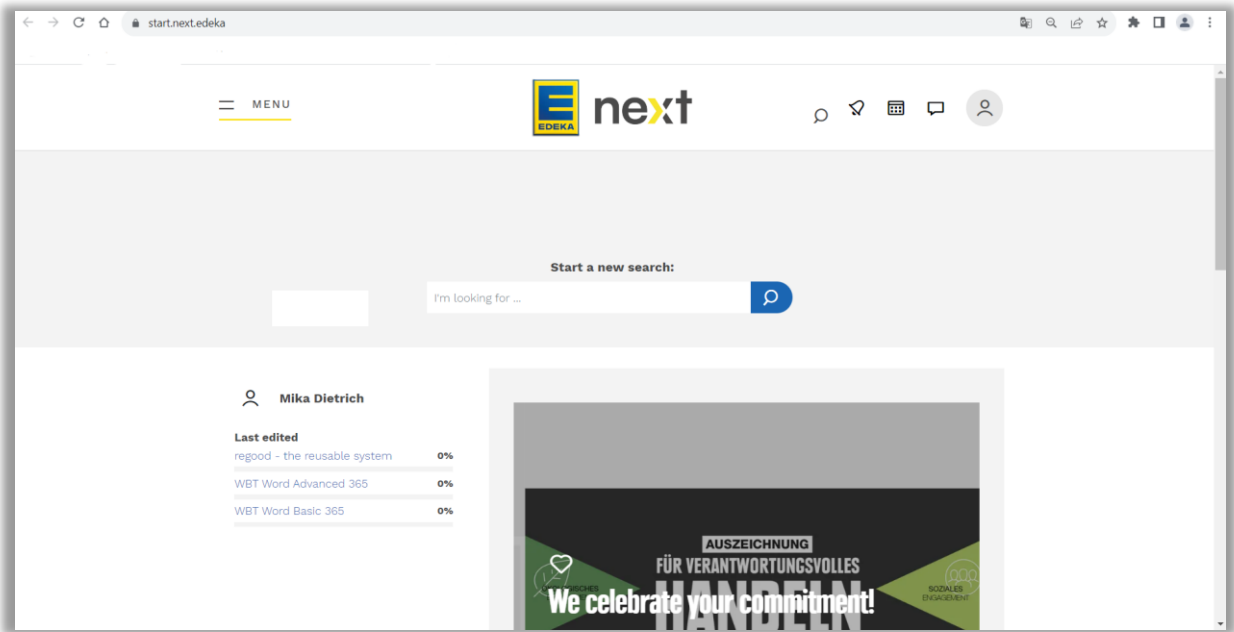
Click on LOGIN.



Enter your national id and password and click on LOGIN.

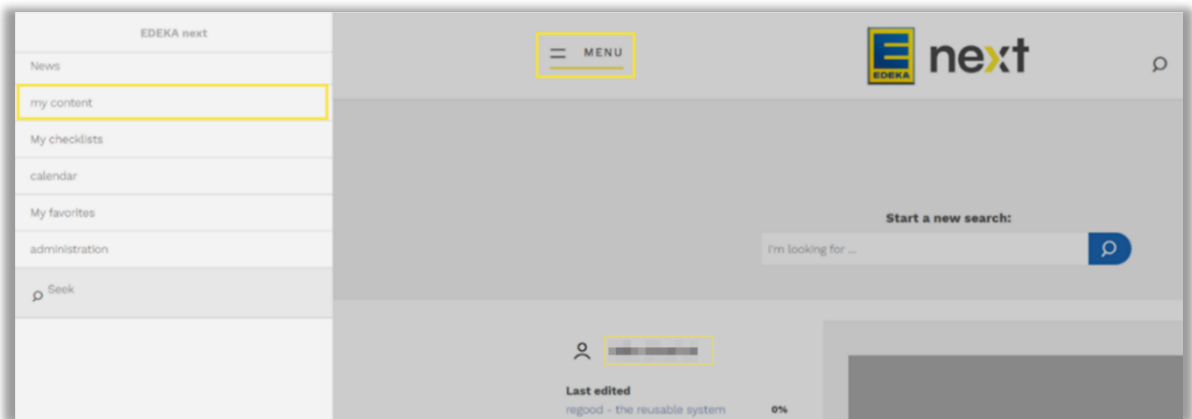


Now you are in the EDEKA next. If you have selected German under 3, EDEKA next will automatically be displayed in your desired language.

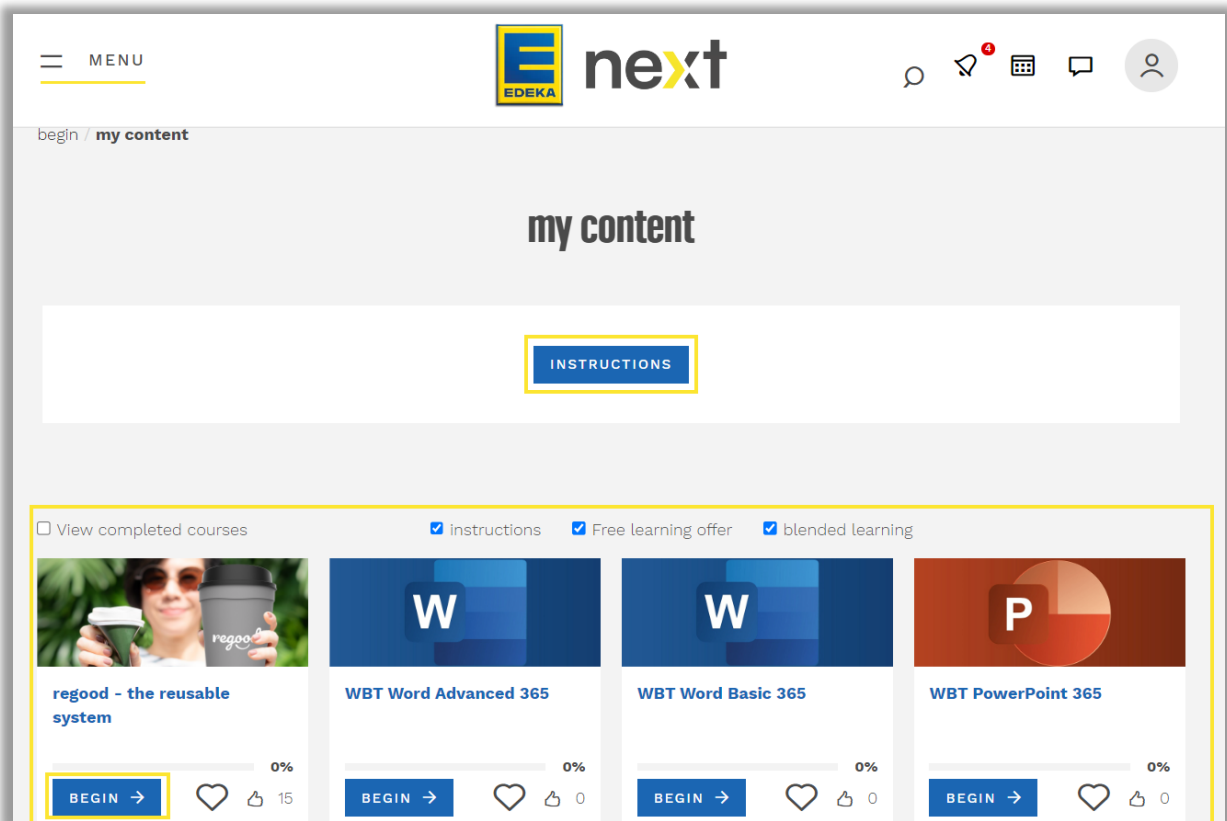


### Step 3: Start and translate your EDEKA next course/instruction

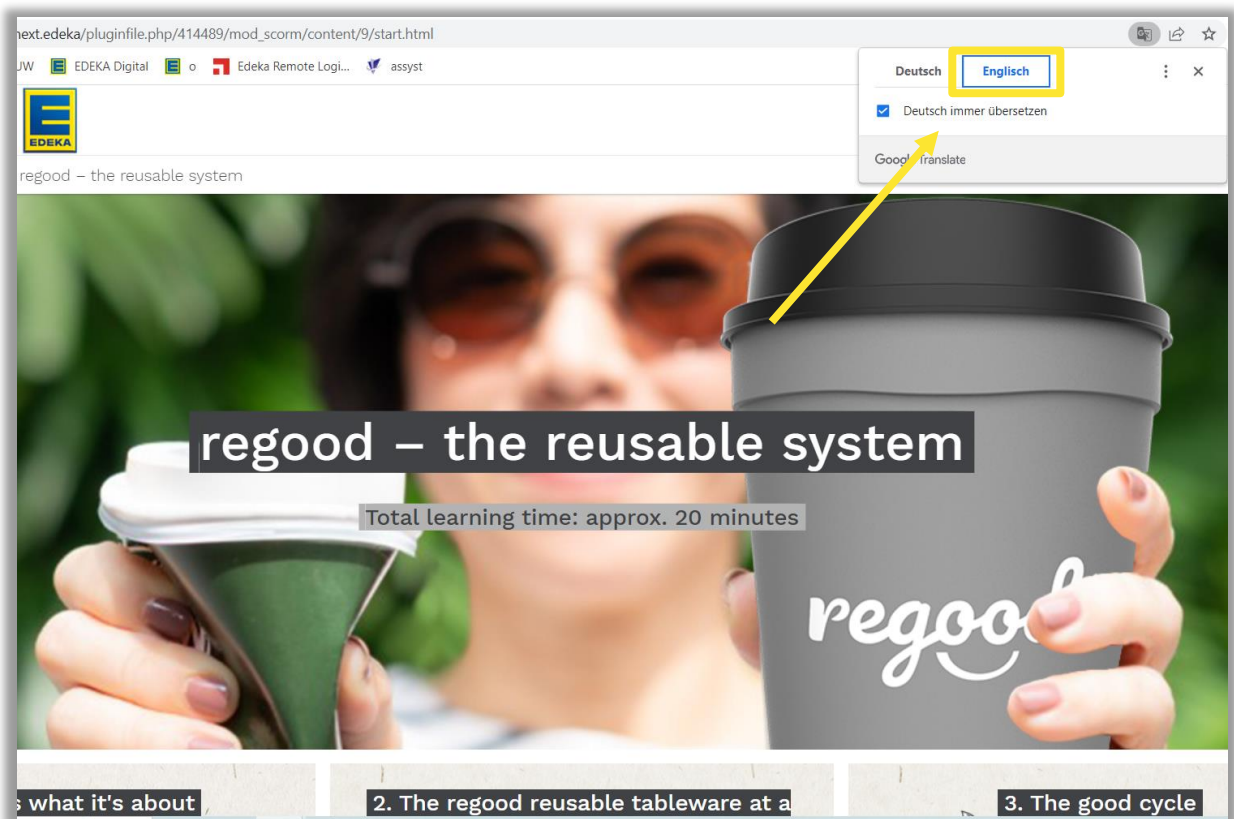
